What if you could both help train the young adults of our community in leadership skills infused with energy, compassion, and an emphasis on empathy for others? What if at the same time as you assisted in the formation of these young adults, you could serve the needy of our community with donations of food, clothing, financial support in cash or gift cards, or physical support to complete a task? The response to these questions created the mission statement of an organization built to achieve these goals. Serving Other Souls is this organization.

Serving Other Souls is a 501c3 non-profit who has created multiple chapters of servant-leadership groups built to create leaders through service based initiatives. The members of SOS are from the following locations:

- Students from **Franklin Regional Middle School**, in Murrysville, PA
- Students of **O'Block Jr. High**, in Plum, PA
- Jr. high and High School students who participate in **St. Bernadette's Catholic Church Youth Group**

These members from our three chapters are dedicated to helping individuals with great need. SOS members can offer their time, talent, or treasure to SOS service projects that aim to improve the lives of those who require aid. The overall goal of Serving Other Souls is to increase empathy and decrease apathy in all SOS members as we serve those souls who require assistance. With these beliefs and goals in mind, SOS creates service events with the following goals:

- **Provide support** to those in need (financial, physical, or emotional)
- **Improve empathy of students** and **improve organizational skills** who volunteer
- **Offer hope** to all those who attend an SOS event

Serving Other Souls creates events throughout the school year to train our members and assist the needy. We have events that arise out of some great need such as a flood, tornado, or hurricane, but we do implement four core annual events each year that are the mainstay of our time and energy. These events include:

- **Thanksgiving Food Drive** (3 weeks leading up to Thanksgiving) (Generates 150 meals for needy in multiple areas)
- **Homeless Clothing Drive** (3 weeks leading up to Winter Break) (Clothing & boots for 100 homeless folks annually)
- **Ronald McDonald House Dinners** (SOS chapters each visit RMH multiple times per year to prepare, cook, serve dinners to the families living at the RMH while their sick children are receiving care in Children's Hospital.)
- **Miles of Smiles 5K and 1 Mile Walk** (Memorial Day annually) (raises \$25,000 to \$40,000 annually for multiple families in our communities that are battling various forms of cancer)

Since the inception of SOS in 2011, we have handed out over \$300,000 in food, clothing, and monies to the needy of our communities. This type of charity does not happen without the support of members of our communities and the businesses within these communities. SOS is seeking financial or material support from you or your business organization to help us maintain the excellence we have set as a standard since our inception in 2011.
